Patients in Isolation Precautions

- Adhere to Infection Control policy when entering the patient's room who is in Contact, Droplet, or Airborne precautions.



Prior to entering room- Clean Hands!



Gel In Gel Out
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Please Note: Per Standard Precautions

Staff should wear gloves or other PPE while performing a task beyond the patient care zone when there is reasonable anticipation that contact with blood, body fluid or an open wound may occur.

Gel your hands before donning gloves



Hand Hygiene is not required when exiting with patient during Rehabilitative Service,



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Working with patient during Rehabilitative Service,



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or return patient to room



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Upon completion of patient service, remove and discard gloves



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Clean hands on exiting patient room



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Do not wear gloves in hallway unless performing patient care
